



# **Back to Campus Timeline:**

Phase 1	August 31 - September 2	Virtual student & parent orientation sessions.
Phase 2	September 5 - September 23	Online learning.
Phase 3	September 26 - October 21	On-campus learning at 50% capacity.
Phase 4	October 24 onwards	On-campus learning with social distancing and classes not greater than 20 students.
Phase 5	To be determined by the MOE & MOH	Full on-campus attendance at regular schedules.

# Phase 3 Learning Model (50% capacity):

# Hybrid Classroom:





In accordance with the MOE and the MOH a **2m distance between students** is implemented to ensure a safe and healthy environment in all classrooms.

#### **Preschool & Elementary School**

Each homeroom is split in half. Group A will attend school on-campus in the morning and group B will attend on-campus in the afternoon. Provision for online learning will be provided to students who cannot attend campus due to an approved exemption.

#### Middle School & HighSchool

Each homeroom is split in half. Group A will attend on-campus on a full schedule for one week, while group B is learning online from home via synchronous live sessions. Groups will alternate week on, week off. Provision for online learning will be provided to students who cannot attend campus due to an approved exemption.





For all school divisions and grade levels, there is the provision for continuity of learning with online instruction via Zoom, in addition to supplementary work for those students who cannot attend school physically, such as chronic COVID-related health conditions and quarantine/self-isolation requirements.

## **Daily Schedule and Timing:**

### Preschool:

Students will attend on-campus learning every day, and will complete their program with both their English and Arabic homeroom teachers. Students will also engage in specialist classes such as Music and PE.

# **Elementary School:**

Students will attend on-campus learning every day, and will engage in all core and specialist subjects across the week on a reduced schedule to comply with MOE and MOH guidelines.

Students will participate in a full, regular schedule of learning including all core and elective courses across all grade levels.

#### **General Safety Precautions:**

- Masks are compulsory for all staff, students, and visitors aged 6 and above at all times while on campus.
- Enhanced screening procedures at each entry gate using MyMedBot app, in addition to temperature checks at entrance with thermal camera thermometers.
- Extensive health and safety signage around the campus in hallways, classrooms, common areas, floors, playground, etc.
- NanoSeptic self-cleaning surfaces installed on all high-touch areas of the campus, i.e. door handles, elevator buttons, etc.
- Ventilation upgrades include HEPA filters and/or UV light systems installed to all AC units, and stand alone air purification units in all classrooms.
- Each student will have his/her own stationery and classroom items for personal use no sharing of items.
- Canteen, MakerSpace, Media Center and Atelier closed to students until further notice.
- No large events for staff or students until further notice.
- No field trips until further notice.
- No KASAC/OASIS sport events until further notice.
- Suspected cases will be directed to isolation rooms near Gate 1 and Gate 5.
- The school has a COVID response team that meets regularly to ensure all measures are in place and followed.







#### **Communication:**

- Videos on procedures for students in each division have been shared on the 'Back to Campus' tab of the BBS website.
- There will be a range of Q & A and orientation meetings for parents and students as per the above schedule to discuss procedures for school return and to answer questions.
- Series of virtual orientation sessions for students and parents before school starts.
- Weekly updates for parents.
- The 'Back to Campus' tab on the BBS website has a host of useful information, including:
  - Daily COVID dashboard
  - Reopening Videos
  - Reopening plans
  - Flowcharts, protocols, etc.
  - Social/emotional support and resources
  - FAQs

# **Contact tracing and notification:**

• Accurate records will be kept by the school nurses, including robust contact tracing protocols. School secretaries, receptionists and admin assistants will assist in contract tracing and notifying parents. Student, class or school closure depends on the number of cases, type of contact, and other factors. It may be done by small group, class, floor or by division based on the case.

#### **Food and Beverage:**

- Canteen will be closed until further notice.
- PS and ES students will eat in their classrooms.
- Students will bring their own food and water everyday. It is important for students to bring their own water bottles.
- Water dispensers are covered.

# **Sanitization and Social Distancing:**

- There will be set times for washing hands and sanitization: before entering the building, before entering the classroom, before eating etc.
- Flow in and out of the building will be explained to students step by step. Students will follow marks on the floor. Detailed maps are in full reopening guide.
- All movement of students around and within the building is to be supervised by an adult and adhere to the expected two meters distance indoors and 1.5 meters outdoors.

# **Compliance:**

- BBS has complied with, and in many cases will exceed MOE and MOH requirements and quidelines.
- The reopening plan is in alignment with CDC guidelines related to school reopenings.

# **Precautionary Measures:**



Wall posters on all school screens and social media about COVID-19 including all preventive measures to be taken.







Put social distancing reminder marks/cues on the ground around the campus and buildings (indoor and outdoor). Consider one-way paths and staircases, additional barriers.
