The Pre-K Program

Our Pre-K Program is part of the Preschool campus serving students through activities that are inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach to early childhood education.

Assessment is always on-going throughout the year. Pre-K children have three "Reports" in a year. Children are assessed via daily documentation and have a learning portfolio.

The Pre-K instructional day is comprised of blocks of English and Arabic instruction that is equally divided, as well as a mid-day break for children to eat snack and enjoy recess. Physical Education and music is integrated into the program. Pre-K students visit the Atelier twice a week for exploration through Reggio inspired activities.

Class sizes are currently set at 22 in Pre-K. The day timings for teachers is 7:00 a.m. to 2:50 p.m., and children are in session from 7:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. Each teacher has a teacher assistant and a helper in the classroom.
